# Installation

- 1. The EP-FS range should only be installed by a competent, suitably trained technician, experienced in installation with hazardous voltages. (>50Vac & <1000Vac or >75Vdc & 1500Vdc)
- 2. Ensure that all power is disconnected before carrying out any work on the EP-FS range.
- 3. Separate the cover from the housing base.
- 4. Mount the housing base as required, if flush mounting a minimum box depth of 35mm is recommended.
- 5. Terminate the cores leaving some slack inside the unit.
- 6. Replace the front cover.
